May is just around the corner. Flowers are blooming, the grass is growing, and the course is really starting to green up!

Just a few quick notes ... we will be planting flowers on the course on Tuesday May 5th. There is a sign-up sheet in the Pro Shop for members who want to help. We will start planting around 10:30am. The irrigation is up and running (yeah!) with no major problems. Over the next month or so we will be making some minor improvements to the system so we can move closer to full automation. I'm sure by now everyone has noticed the poa-anna or annual bluegrass seedheading in the greens and fairways. We actually sprayed a growth regulator on the greens to help keep it suppressed although it may not seem like it while playing on them, but it does help. Unfortunately, there isn't a whole lot we can do to rid the course of poa, but we can begin to manage it by not letting it to seedhead and overseed with bentgrass to crowd it out. The good thing is, poa only seedheads once a year and only for a couple weeks or so. Weed control on the course will be an ongoing thing over the next month ... dandelion, clover, etc.

We will be repairing the restrooms behind #16 green in the next couple of weeks with the help of **Bob Jordan**. Thanks Bob! A special thanks also goes out to **Dick Murdock** for his help during greens aerification. As always, if you have any questions, feel free to call.
